Elected Officials

To help teach kindergarten students about elected officials:

<u>Election Day Simulation for a Mascot</u>: Organize a simplified
"Election Day" within the classroom. Create ballots with pictures of
different candidates (animals / cartoon characters etc.) and have
the students cast their votes. Afterward, discuss the concept of
voting and how elected officials are chosen.

<u>Create a Class Constitution:</u> Together with the students, create a simple class constitution that outlines rules and responsibilities within the classroom. Discuss the importance of rules and how they relate to elected officials making laws.

<u>Craft Projects:</u> Engage students in craft activities where they create campaign posters, "I Voted" buttons, or mini government buildings using art supplies. This hands-on approach can reinforce the concept of elected officials.

Elected Official or Government Helper

Engage students in a conversation about who elected officials are and who Government helpers are. (Mayors, council, governors, prime minister, presidents vs firefighter, mail carriers, construction road workers, doctors etc.)

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
