2. How many 22 cm pieces of rope can you cut from a rope that is 352 cm long?

3. You have 1,200 pears and want to share them equally with 50 people. How many pears would each person get?

4. Jackie made 1,175 cookies for a bake sale. She put the cookies in bags, with 47 cookies in each bag. How many bags did she have for the bake sale?
