

2. You have 18 marbles but you gave your friend 9. Now how many marbles do you have?
3. You have 39 cents in your piggy bank. Show 3 different ways using pennies, nickels, dimes that could be in your bank.
4. When I looked outside, I saw 10 legs. How many dogs and people were outside?
5. If you were counting backwards by 2s starting at 28, how many numbers would you have said before you get to 12?
6. Show how a box of oranges in a single layer would be packed in a crate if there were 16 oranges in the crate and each row had 4 oranges. If 4 people shared the oranges, how many would they each get?
7. If you had a bouquet of balloons and the wind blew away 7 leaving you only with 8, how many did you start with? **Show your work.**
8. Jake has 7 pennies and Jill gave him 8 more. How many does he have now?
9. 6 friends are sharing 18 treats. How many treats will each of them get?
10. Show how you can take 24 marbles and share them fairly with 6 friends.

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2nd Grade — Answers

1. 37 cents.
2. 9 marbles.
3. (39 pennies),(3 dimes, 1 nickel and 4 pennies) etc.
4. 2 dogs and 1 person or 3 people and 1 dog.
5. You will say 9 numbers to get to 12. (including 28 and 12)
6. The child should draw a 4x4 array. Each child gets 4 oranges.
