Vocabulary

<u>Traits</u>: distinguishing characteristics

Physical traits a distinguishing trait that you can usually see like color of

flowers, shape of leaves, length of tails, texture of hair

Acquired/learned traits a distinguishing trait that is acquired, ability to sing,

play an instrument, perform tricks

Offspring product of a reproductive process, young seedlings, young

trees, babies, children, baby animals

<u>Inherit</u> a feature or distinguishing characteristics passed on to

offspring

DNA instructions in our cell that determine our genetics

<u>Genes</u> determine which traits will be passed to the offspring

<u>Chromosomes</u> part of the cell that contains our DNA/genetic material

Dominant a trait can be inherited if only one parent has the gene,

it is the stronger trait

Recessive a trait inherited from both parents, to inherit this trait,

both parents must have the gene, it is the weaker trait
