Abstract Nouns

Abstract nouns are sometimes referred to as idea nouns. They are called abstract nouns because you can't see or touch them. **Examples of abstract nouns are:** trust, bravery, pain, courage, love, peace, taste, education, friendship, thought, faith, dream. Be careful when using abstract nouns. For instance: I love the **taste** of candy. **Taste** is a noun. BUT, Did you **taste** it? Taste is a verb. OR, I had a scary **dream** last night. Dream is a noun Vs Did you **dream** last night? Not a noun.
