Learn to Write Paragraphs Tasks:



Task 1: Write an <u>opinion</u> paragraph about an opinion you have about something. (something you like, or don't like.)

Task 2: Write a <u>descriptive</u> paragraph about something you saw or somewhere you went.

Task 3: Write a <u>process</u> paragraph. This will indicate a step by step procedure on how to do something or play a game.

Task 4: Write a <u>definition</u> paragraph. A definition paragraph explains a concept. For instance: What is a pet? What is a circus? What is a park? What is soccer?

Task 5: Write a <u>narrative</u> paragraph. This paragraph is about a movie you watched or a book you read or an event that happened.

Paragraph Writing Task Ideas:

Task 1: Opinions

What you think about best: place to live, best game to play, best movie ever, best type of pet. How you feel about homework or wearing uniforms to school. How you feel about recycling or the driving age or if all bike riders should have to have a license or if you think school should be a 4 day week.

Task 2: Descriptive

Describe a place you went, a type of sport, a scary place, a haunted house, a type of plant/tree, beach, describe your friend, hero or a relative, describe your favorite trip, describe a thunderstorm.

Task 3: Process

How to make a recipe, how to play a game, how to make your bed, how to paint something, how to draw something, how to care for your pet, how to cut the grass, how to behave, how to recycle.

Task 4: Definition

Explain what recycling is, explain what healthy eating is, explain what a tornado or hurricane is. Explain what a tent is, what glaciers are, what elephants are. Explain what any man made product is or explain your choice of any living thing.,

Task 5: Narrative

Write about an alien invasion, or a talking pet, or the day the robot visited or when the tree talked, a wizard adventure, the flying hero, when you were teacher or boss for a day.

You may also be creative and think of something to write about as long as it fits with the 5 types of writing for your paragraph..
